All dining plans are sales tax-free and can be used at any of the 20 on-campus dining locations!

Mandatory First-Year Resident Student Dining Plan Options:

All incoming first-year residents are required to purchase either Level A, B or C.

Other Dining Plan Options:

Other resident, transfer and commuting students can take advantage of levels A-F. Level G is available only to commuting students.

Level A:

This plan provides you with **1,865** points.

Cost per semester	\$1,865
Suggested weekly usage	\$116
Average per day	\$16.57

Level B:

This plan provides you with **1,760** points.

Cost per semester	\$1,760
Suggested weekly usage	\$110
Average per day	\$15.71

Level C:

This plan provides you with **1,630** points.

Cost per semester	\$1,630
Suggested weekly usage	\$102
Average per day	\$14.57

Level D:

This plan provides you with **1,445** points.

Cost per semester	\$1,445
Suggested weekly usage	\$90
Average per day	\$12.85

Level E:

This plan provides you with **1,325** points.

Cost per semester	\$1,325
Suggested weekly usage	\$83
Average per day	\$11.85

Level F:

This plan provides you with **720** points.

Cost per semester	\$720
Suggested weekly usage	\$45
Average per day	\$6.43

*Level G:

This plan provides you with **375** points.

Cost per semester	\$375
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**Available only to commuting students.*

How All Declining Balance Dining Plans Work:

- ▶ After you select and purchase one of the dining plans, the points are activated on your HofstraCard.
- ▶ All declining balance plans come with a predetermined number of points. Points are deducted from the proper account each time a purchase is made, and are nonrefundable.
- ▶ You have a choice of 20 on-campus dining locations that accept payment with the HofstraCard.
- ▶ You may begin making dining plan purchases on the Thursday prior to the first day of undergraduate classes.
- ▶ Fall semester unused points may be carried over to the spring semester provided you purchase the same plan as the fall semester or one of higher value.
- ▶ All unused points are forfeited the day following spring commencement.
- ▶ All dining plans are sales tax-free.

Q. Am I required to purchase a dining plan?

A. First-year resident students are required to purchase a dining plan. Other students are not required to purchase a dining plan, but with all the benefits, why wouldn't you? Refer to page 2 for your dining plan options.

Dining plan benefits:

- ▶ With 20 dining locations, there's something for everyone. Save tax! Save on gas! Save your parking space!
- ▶ Increased opportunities to take advantage of the academic, social and cultural resources available at Hofstra University while enjoying the multitude of on-campus dining options with flexible hours of operation.
- ▶ Dining plans eliminate the need to carry cash.

Q. If I have dietary restrictions and need assistance, whom can I speak to?

A. We have an on-site registered nutritionist available for one-on-one counseling. She can also be reached via e-mail through our Web site at hofstra.edu/askthenutritionist.

Q. What should I do if I lose my HofstraCard?

A. A lost or stolen HofstraCard should be reported to the HofstraCard Services Office immediately by phone at **(516) 463-6942** or in person at **104 Mack Student Center, North Campus**.



Q. Can I change my dining plan?

A. Yes. You can make changes to your dining plan up until the third week of the semester.

Q. How do I keep track of my points?

A. Each time you use your HofstraCard to make a purchase, your account balance will appear on the register screen. You may request a printed receipt at any time.

Q. What do I do if I am running out of points?

A. Additional points can be purchased online at my.hofstra.edu under the Hofstra Online tab, or you may visit the Office of HofstraCard Services, 104 Mack Student Center.

Q. Will my unused points carry over from one semester to the next?

A. Points may be carried over from the fall semester to the spring semester provided that you purchase the same plan or a plan of higher value for the spring semester. All points are forfeited the day after spring commencement.

Q. Can I use my points anywhere on campus?

A. Yes. Points are accepted anywhere on campus, including the Mack Sports and Exhibition Complex and Shuart Stadium. In addition, your points are also accepted by Hofstra University Catering Services, which includes the Hofstra University Club, an upscale dining venue that may be reserved for special functions only (hofstrauniversityclub.com).
