**Colonel E. David Woycik, Jr.**



Colonel E. David Woycik, Jr. was born in Glen Cove, New York. His civilian education included the U.S. Naval Academy, Hofstra University and Hofstra Law School.

Colonel Woycik was commissioned in May 1977. Upon graduation from law school, he attended Military Police School and graduated in 1979. He served as the mobilization officer for the 800th MP Brigade and was the executive officer for 423rd MP Company. After obtaining his commission in the Judge Advocate General Corps, he served with the 301st Area Support Group (ASG) at Fort Totten, New York. He was the assistant staff judge advocate for the 301st when they deployed to Saudi Arabia for Desert Shield/Desert Storm in 1990. He served in Saudi Arabia and Kuwait and was the liaison to the 22nd Support Command. On return from Southwest Asia, he joined the 4th LSO where he was the assistant S3 and the senior trial defense counsel. In September 1999 he was appointed the staff judge advocate of the 301st (ASG). In September 2000 he was appointed the staff judge advocate for the 77th Regional Support Command, Fort Totten, New York. In 2001 he returned to the 301st (ASG) as the command SJA. In February 2002 he was promoted to colonel and appointed SJA for the 1079th Garrison Support Unit at Fort Dix, New Jersey. In January 2003 he was mobilized to active duty as the staff judge advocate, Fort Dix, New Jersey. Colonel Woycik is a graduate of the Military Police School (officer basic and advanced courses), Judge Advocate General School (officer basic and advanced courses), and Command and General Staff College, and was selected for the Army War College.

E. David Woycik began his civilian legal career as prosecutor for the Suffolk County district attorney's office. Since 1985, he has been in private practice in New York and is currently a partner at Sanders, Sanders, Block, Woycik, Viener & Grossman, P.C. He concentrates his practice in the area of trial litigation. He is a faculty member at Hofstra and Widener Schools of Law in the National Institute for Trial Advocacy Program. He also lectures extensively for the American Trial Lawyers Association, New York State Bar Association and Nassau Bar Association.

Colonel Woycik is on the board of directors of Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Long Island and the Disabled Children's Relief Fund. He is immediate past president of the Hofstra University Veterans Alumni Association, which raises scholarship funds for children of Veterans and established a Veterans Memorial Plaza at Hofstra University. He received the George M. Estabrook Award for Alumni Achievement in 1992 and was recognized by Hofstra University as its Outstanding Alumnus in 1998.

Colonel Woycik's awards include the Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters; Army Commendation Medal; Army Achievement Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters; Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters; National Defense Service Medal with two Bronze Stars; Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Ribbon; Armed Forces Reserve Medal with Silver Hourglass Device and One "M" Device; Army Reserve Component Overseas Training Ribbon with seven Tours; Southwest Asia Service Medal with two Bronze Stars; Kuwait Liberation Medal – Saudi Arabia; Kuwait Liberation Medal – Kuwait; and the Global War on Terrorism Medal.
