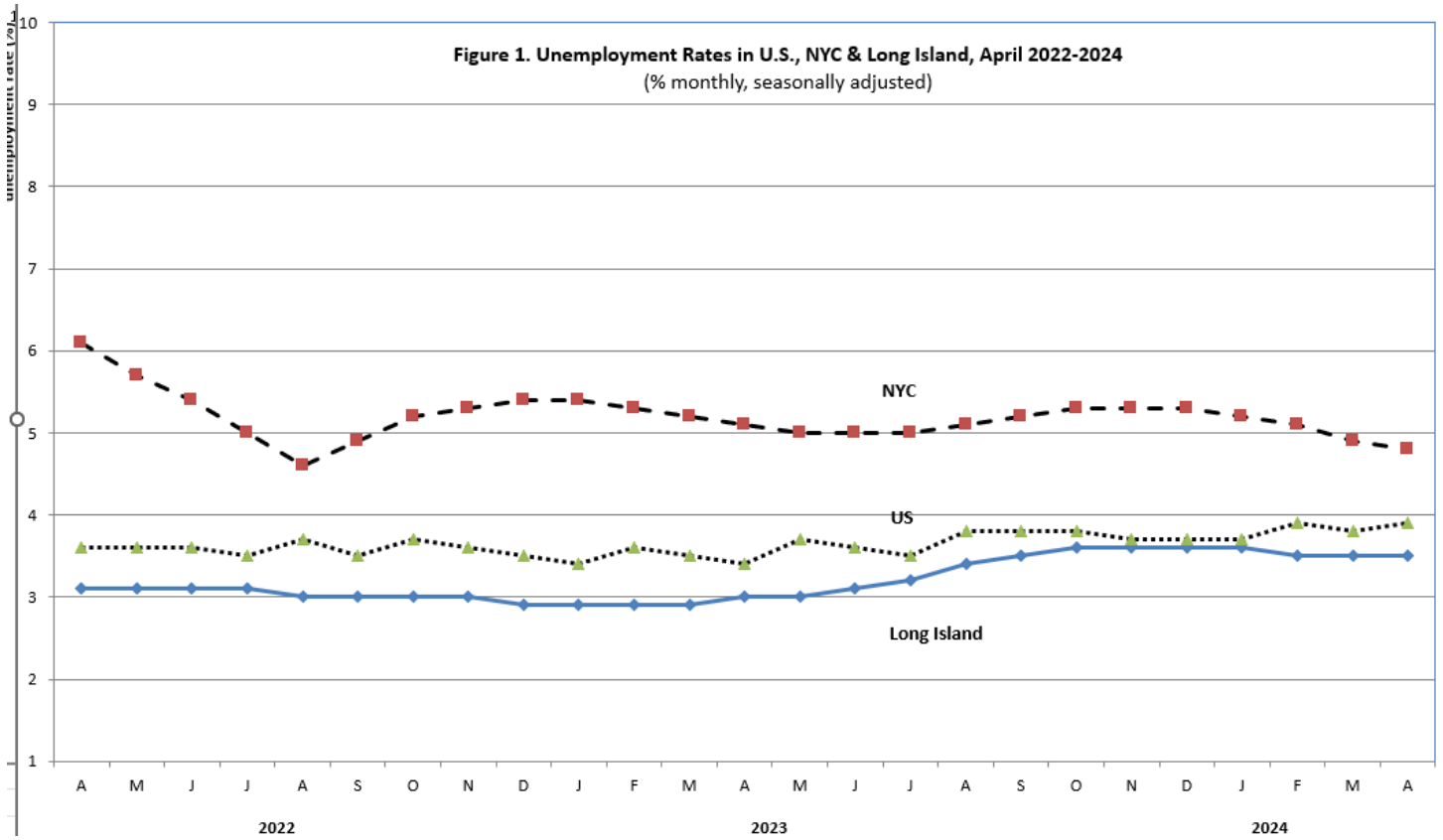

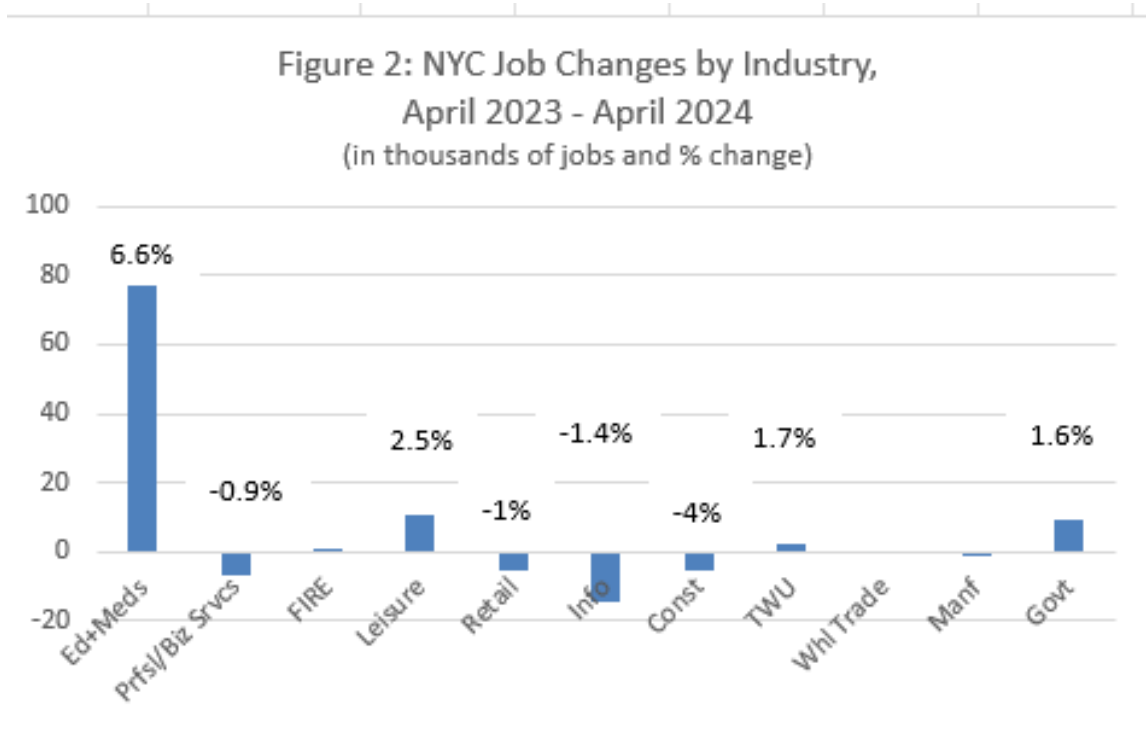


Fig. 3: Long Island Job Changes by Industry,
