On behalf of Hofstra's Department of Political Sciences and Model United Nations Club, I would like to invite your high school to participate in the annual Hofstra University Model United Nations Conference (HUMUNC) from Friday, February 28 through Sunday March 2, 2025. We are also excited to announce a conference theme for HUMUNC 2025: Global Harmony: Collaborative Pathways to a United Future. As an extension of this theme, Hofstra Model United Nations will donate a portion of the proceeds from HUMUNC to Doctors without Borders and their efforts to provide healthcare to those in need.

HUMUNC offers a simulation of the various organs of the United Nations, as well as more specialized crisis style committees in regional bodies. Assuming the roles of ambassadors and other international actors, student delegates make speeches, prepare draft resolutions, negotiate with allies and adversaries, resolve conflicts, and navigate the Model United Nations Conference rules of procedure. In doing so, students obtain a practical understanding of advancing international cooperation and problem solving.

During the three-day conference, students gain exposure to international relations, and they have the opportunity to hone their public speaking and leadership skills. This experience is provided in a more intimate setting and lower cost, thanks to university funding. Hofstra University has distinguished itself by hosting a variety of political events, including the first of three televised presidential debates in 2016, two previous presidential debates, the 2018 New York State gubernatorial debate, and dozens of high-profile conferences and symposia organized through the Peter S. Kalikow Center for the American Presidency and the Center for Civic Engagement. Making use of Hofstra's first-rate facilities, knowledgeable staff, and dynamic students and faculty, HUMUNC provides an unforgettable three days of engaging debate and discussion.

Registration will be on a first come, first served basis until we reach capacity, or through December 13, 2024. All monies must be paid by December 13, 2024. Each of your students will represent a nation participating in each committee (or person for crisis committees). **The maximum number of students per delegation is 20.**

REGISTRATION: Each school team must submit this delegation application. In addition, each high school student must fill out a delegate credential form. This is a conference for high school students only.

FEES: **The fee is \$65 per delegate if registered before December 13, 2024.** No delegation fee will be charged. Fees are nonrefundable. The deadline for all registration paperwork and fees will be December 13, 2024. Advisers should collect the fees from their high school students and forward to Hofstra University. Country and committee assignments will be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. All documentation and fees must be received by no later than December 13, 2024. Please note that we do usually have a wait list for this conference, so we appreciate receiving all fees and documentation on time.
