Our new policy is called "Study Policy Prohibiting Sex Discrimination, Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence, Dating Violence, and Stalking. This combiens federal anmd state law to protect pregnant or expectant students and their spouses. It expands reporting obligations for faculty and staff. More details in the provided presentation.  - a) Secretary Egolf: How will this affect online forums that were created last year to sponsor students who ran out of money? These wouldn't go through Compass would this be a legal issue?
 - (1) President Anniballi: This isn't intended to be a replacement of that. Anything private or sponsoring a friend is fine. Some issues come up with Boost on the back end, but this guarantees 250 meals on top of whoever else may want to pay for people they know.

- b) Chair Mahlati: What is the point of this program if it essentially is just a lottery? On a whole, this does not benefit the majority. Would they not be making a profit either way?
 - (1) President Anniballi: I think right now the focus is not on the bigger picture. This is to get the ball rolling. Hopefully, we see success, and this can be expanded in the future. This is where we start.
- c) Chair Vickers: I understand it is a start, but what is this doing for the rest of the students who can't get meals within the 250? Why can't they up it, which could encourage more people to donate to the program? What is there pushback?
 - (1) President Anniballi: I am not sure what the push backs were. This is just what I was told by the Bursar. Some of it is legal, as at certain times it can reach a point where students who donate would get a tax break because of it being classified as a donation. Like right now, you can donate your money at the end of the semester which you would qualify for a tax form. This is what they are trying to avoid.
- d) Chair Quail: I know it starts small for now, but I think we need to take this as a win, see how it goes, and try to expand it in the coming years.
 - (1) President Anniballi: Exactly. Students who have been identified as food insecure will get first priority since they do not have the means to add more money onto their plans. This is where I think a staggered approach could work to make sure they get priority.
